

## Grassfed Beef Frequently Asked Questions

Q. What kind of cattle do you have?

A. Angus Cross

Q. Where are your cattle processed?

A. Creston Valley Meats, a small USDA inspected processing plant

Q. Is there a risk for mad cow disease (BSE)?

A. 100 percent grass-fed animals cannot acquire BSE because their diets contain no animal by-products or any *other* unnatural ingredients. Cattle that have been raised on pasture all of their lives *eliminates all possibility of mad cow disease* because the animals are never fed anything but pasture grasses and hay.

Q. Where are your cattle raised?

A. On ranches in Los Osos and Cayucos

Q. Do you sell quarters, halves, and full sides of beef?

A. Yes, we do but because grassfed beef is seasonal bulk orders require as much advance notice as possible and are only available from late Spring to early Summer

Q. Do you sell any meat that is not frozen?

A. No, because it is so seasonal all of the meat we sell is frozen

Q. Do you use Antibiotics or Growth Hormones?

A. No, all of our animals are absolutely antibiotic and hormone free
